It only takes 48 hours

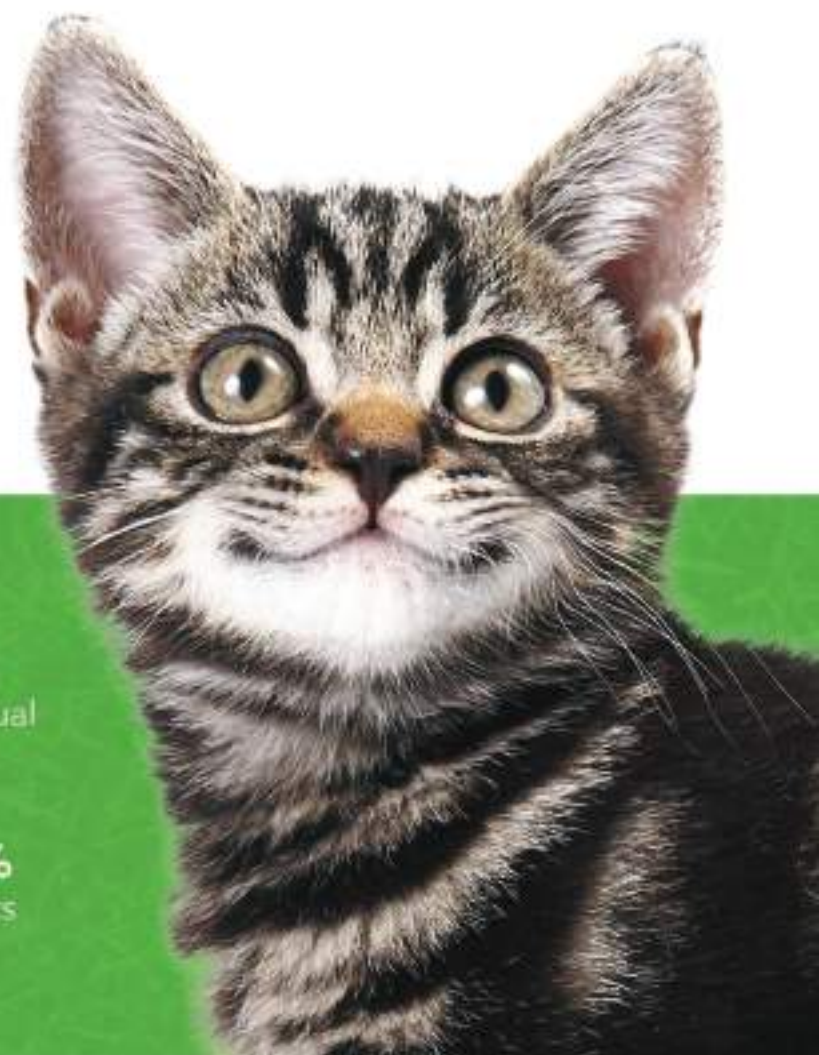
